### **Main Directions of the Conference:**

1. Population distribution and reproduction: historical trends, characteristics of formation and problems of the post-Soviet period.
2. Socio-economic, ecological and political aspects of regional development.
3. Historical-, economic and ecological-geographical problems of development of cities and urbanized territories.
4. Ecological problems of human livelihood and recreation, and of specially protected natural areas in the Siberian settings.
5. Integrated mapping of nature, the economy and population.

### **Topics of the proposed round table discussions:**

- Man in landscapes of Siberia, and ethnocultural features in a transforming world.
- Transboundary relations of neighboring countries in Eurasian space, geographical and ecological problems of the economic corridor (China–Mongolia–Russia), and the future of Siberia.

Before the beginning of the conference, the electronic version of the contributions will be compiled and posted in the Russian Science Citation Index (RSCI) database. Contributions should be mailed before June 1, 2019 to [conf.irk.2019@gmail.com](mailto:conf.irk.2019@gmail.com).

- **full-time participation (oral presentation and publication of contributions);**
- **full-time participation (poster presentation and publication of contributions);**
- **correspondence participation (publication of contributions).**

#### **General requirements for the preparation of materials**

1. The text size should not exceed four A4 pages, including figures, tables and the list of references. Pages are not numbered.
2. File format – Microsoft Word not below the 2003 version 2003 (DOC and DOCX).
3. Page size – A4. Margins: top and bottom – 2 cm, left – 3 cm, right – 1.5 cm. Times New Roman; point size 12 pt; 1 line spacing.
4. Procedure of preparing the text. The first line should indicate the name of the paper – in CAPITAL letters, bold font, without hyphenation, center alignment. Leaving one line spacing, the next line should indicate the last name and initials of the author(s) in Russian, in lower-case letters, center alignment; the authors' last names should be followed by upper indices – Arabic numerals (if the authors are from different organizations). The next line – the name of the organization, full address in Russian, e-mail in lower-case letters, in italics, center alignment. Leaving one line spacing, the next line should include the name of the contribution in English; center alignment, capital letters, bold font. Leaving one line spacing, the last names and initials of the authors in Latin letters; center alignment, lower-case letters. The next line – name of the organization, full address in English, e-mail, center alignment, in lower-case letters and in italics. Further, leaving one line spacing, the main body of the text is placed; alignment justified; paragraph indentation – 1 cm; paragraph indentation with the tabulator or blanks is not permitted.
5. Illustrations (figures, photographs, plots, diagrams, etc.) should be inserted into the text. Furthermore, figures, photographs, scanned images, etc. are presented as a separate file in .JPG format; recommended resolution is at least 300 dpi. Figures can be both black-and-white and color figures. Figure captions should always be included: the figure number and name are placed under the illustration, normal font, center alignment, without word hyphenation and paragraph indentation. Tables should be placed in the text; the table number (alignment on the right) and heading (center alignment) are placed under the table. Formulas generated in the formula editor should be numbered. A reference to the formula number is indicated in the text in parentheses.
6. The list of references (without the “References” title) is placed in alphabetical order by leaving 1 line spacing under the text. References (in alphabetical order) to publications in Russian should precede references in foreign languages. The list of references should adhere to the requirements of GOST 7.1-2003 “Bibliographic record. Bibliographic description. General requirements and rules”. A reference to the source should be made in the text by a numeral in square brackets [4].
7. For the sample template, see below.
8. The name of the file with materials for the conference should consist of the first author's last name and initials in Latin letters; for example: `ivanov_ab.doc`. The subject of the message should read “Materials”. All materials are sent for consideration by the Conference Organizing Committee. The authors will be notified about the acceptance of their papers.
